

# Saint Report

All Confirmation Candidates are required to select ONE (1) saint and submit a report about him/her to the Confirmation Coordinator (this should be completed during your first year of Confirmation classes).

The saint report MUST include:

- At least (can be more than) one page, typed, double-spaced, Times New Roman, 12pt font with a heading that includes: Candidate name, paper subject, Catechist name, and date (example is attached)
- Must be in Candidate's own words and not copied from text or computer generated (Don't copy and paste from wikipedia)

The report MUST answer the following questions:

- Who was the Saint
- Life facts
- Date and place of birth
- Date, place, and circumstances of their death
- What did he/she do to become a Saint?
- What do you admire about him/her?
- Why did you choose this Saint?
- What symbols are associated with your Saint?
- Feast Day

Remember to choose your saint carefully. This will be your Confirmation name, so choose a saint that has meaning for you. You are able to choose a male or female saint no matter your gender/sex. For online references, go to either:
